Hitherto hath the LORD helped us. We have crossed over into 2021 by God's grace and mercies. We are still facing a pandemic, however, the fact that we are still here, is a great testament to the keeping power of God, and for that we continue to honour and to praise Him.

Please note the following Prayer Points and Focus Scriptures for our twenty-one (21) days Consecration Week in January 2021, along with the various Prayer times and sessions.

PRAYER SESSIONS

Kindly note for this fast, the prayer sessions are as follows:

- **Corporate Prayer**: Early mornings at 6:00am and evenings at 19:30pm (*Tues. with Mt Zion*)
- **Midday Prayer**: Everyone should have chosen a day (between Monday and Saturday) in which they will pray from 12pm to 1:00pm each week, over the 21 days (except Sundays).
- **All-Night Prayer**: All-night prayer, Friday 29th from 12:30am to 6:00am
- **No Food Tuesday 19th**: Please note also, we will go straight through, **without breaking the fast**, on Tuesday 19th to Wednesday 20th. (*That means, after breaking the fast on Monday 18th, we will not eat again until Wednesday when we break the fast at 4:00pm*) **Please follow the instruction of your doctors before participating in this action, and over the fast.**
- **FASTING INSTRUCTIONS**
- **CAUTION: For those of you who are on tablets which require you to eat before taking, please follow the instructions provided by your GP or pharmacist. Should you need to break your fast earlier for medical reasons, please do so.**
- I encourage you throughout the Fasting period, to eat **only** foods grown (fruits, vegetables, potatoes, yams, etc.) and; of foods which was alive; **only** fish or chicken. Please refrain from foods processed and red meat. Be careful in food preparation, as it is imperative to take care of your stomach. **Please stay away from fried foods during the Fast. Please do NOT consume fizzy, sugary drinks or milk.**
- **For Married Couples**
- Kindly abstain from marital relations during this time of consecration. If your spouse is unsaved or not a member of our ministry, kindly discuss the fast directive affecting them, and exercise wisdom without, placing undue strain on your marriage.
- **LORD SUPPER takes place on Sunday 31st during our Zoom Service. Please be reminded, this Sunday will be a joint service with Mt. Zion. Lord Place will take place at the end. Seeing we may NOT be in the building. Please pick up your Lord Supper Sacrament prior to the Lord Supper.**
